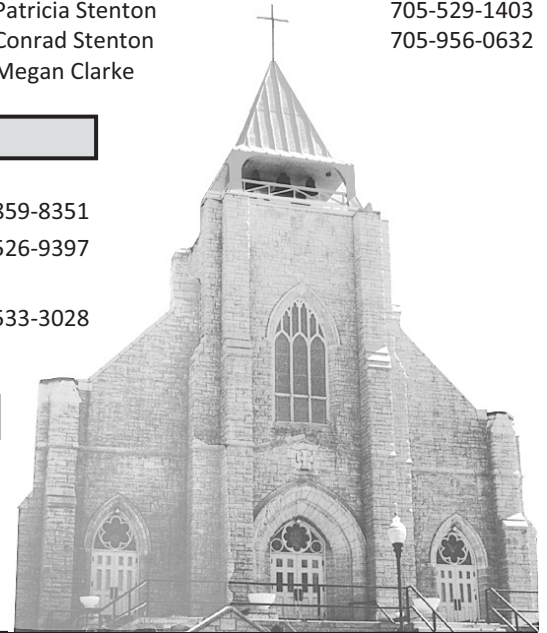

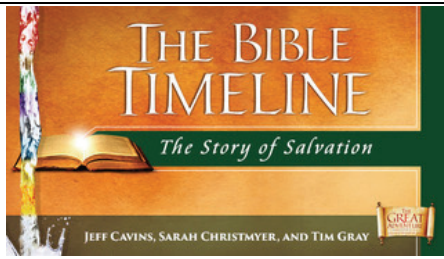

 Televised Sunday Mass Moves to New Channel**

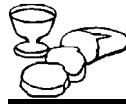
