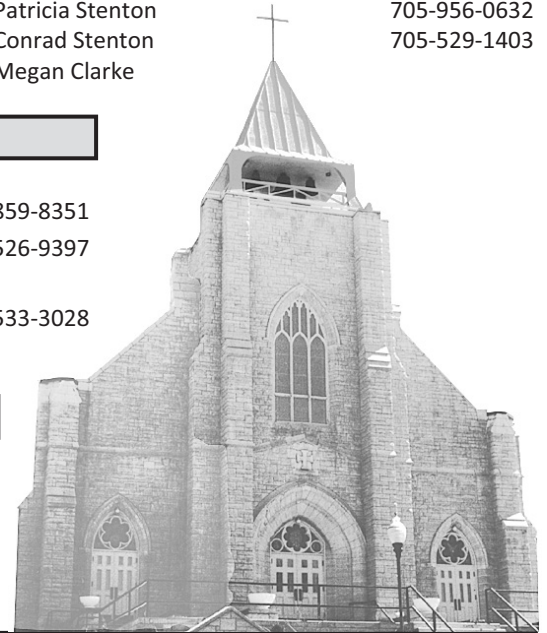

Canadian Bishops Issue Document on Protection of Minors and Vulnerable Adults

On October 4, the bishops of Canada issued new national guidelines for the protection of minors in Canada. Entitled *Protecting Minors from Sexual Abuse: A Call to the Catholic Faithful in Canada for Healing, Reconciliation, and Transformation*, this document first and foremost, focuses on minors and vulnerable adults, whom Canada's bishops wish to protect from sexual violence. We do this by helping them recognize thoughts and feelings as they arise and then by providing them with ways to manage their inner selves.
