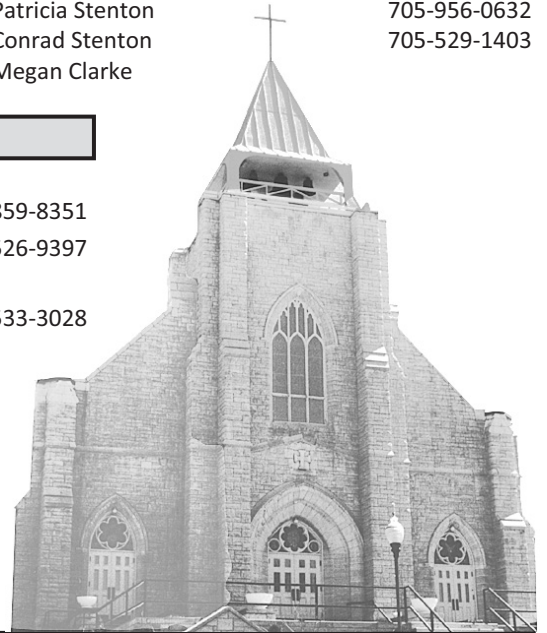

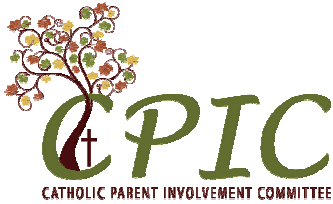

## Countdown to Lent

Lent a time for penance and repentance, for almsgiving and prayer, for working to change attitudes that are not pleasing to God.

**Mark Your Calendars...**

Our Lenten Journey begins with  
Ash Wednesday – March 6, 2019

**Shrove Tuesday**  
is the day before  
Ash Wednesday.

**Carnival**  
comes from the Latin words  
**carne vale**  
meaning  
"farewell to the flesh"

Like other Catholic holidays and celebrations, it likely has its roots in pre-Christian traditions based on the seasons.



**What's with the pancakes?**  
Pancakes were an easy way for Christians to use up their milk, eggs and sugar before the 40 days of fasting during Lent started. Lent involved adopting a simpler diet, without the luxuries of 'fattening' foods.

## WHAT IS SHROVE TUESDAY?

### What does shrove mean?

"Shrove" is the past tense of the verb "to shrive" which means to hear penance and give absolution.

There is a Catholic custom of going to confession on Shrove Tuesday to prepare for Lent.

## WHAT IS LENT?

Lent is a time of prayer and penance, when Christ wants to lead us back to our baptismal promises of dying to sin and of living for God.

### WHEN IS LENT?

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and continues until the afternoon of Holy Thursday. It runs for about 40 days.

**WHY 40 DAYS?** The "40 days" (not including Sundays) of fasting, prayer, and penance before Easter reflect Jesus' 40 days in the wilderness.

### WHAT SHOULD WE DO DURING LENT?

1. Turn away from our sins and turn back to God. Detach from habits and tendencies that are contrary to God's will. Lent is a time of conversion.
2. Open our hearts to our Father, so that we may live with Christ for God. Jesus is calling us to be people of praise and prayer, and living signs of his love for all.

**"This time of fasting opens the gates of heaven to us. Let us welcome it and pray that when Easter comes we may share the joy of the risen Lord."**
