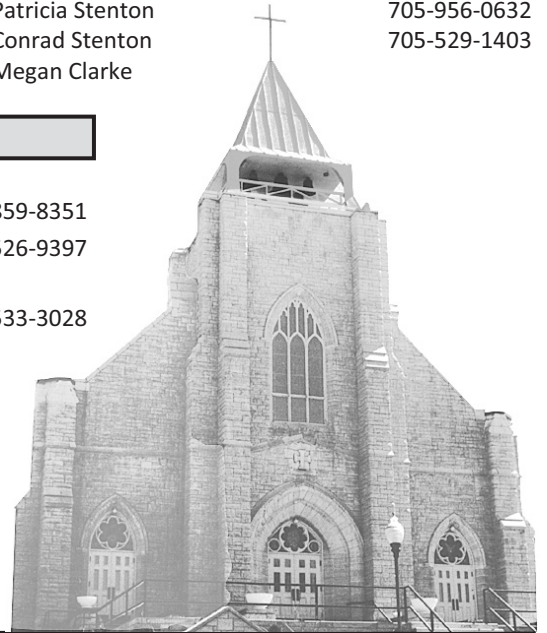

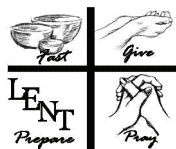

Holy Land Christian Families

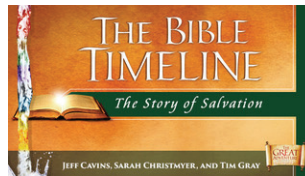
