<u> This Weekend - Candlemas</u>

Today is primarily a Sunday, the Lord's day: the celebration of the paschal mystery. We also remember today the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Forty days after the birth

of Jesus, His parents brought the newborn child to the Temple to present Him to God and offer the sacrifice prescribed by the Mosaic Law. Upon entering the temple the Holy family meets Simeon. Simeon had been promised that "he should not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ" Lk 2:26 In memory of Simeon's canticle acclaiming Jesus as the Light of the people, candles are blessed. Candlelight is like a sword that pierces the darkness with its powerful beam of light & symbol of the vessel of God's power (light) that purifies all it comes in contact with.


Cardinal Collins has designated the weekend of **February 8/9** as Marriage Sunday in the Archdiocese of Toronto.

Marriage Sunday highlights the importance of the sacrament of marriage and complements World Marriage Sunday celebrations that take place across North America.

The Celebration of Marriage Mass will take place **on Sunday**, **February 9, 2020** at **St. Isaac Jogues Parish** (1148 Finch Avenue, Pickering) at **3:00 p.m.**. Cardinal Thomas Collins will preside over this special Mass where all are welcome to attend and married couples will have an opportunity to renew their vows.

Please note that everyone wishing to attend is required to register before the **deadline of February 4**, **2020** to secure a seat.
