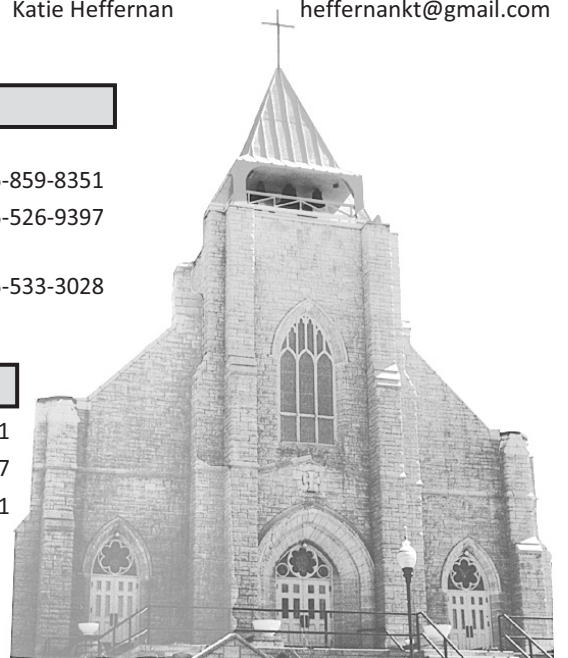

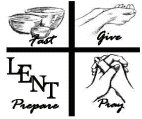

- Canadians with disabilities are more than twice as likely to live in poverty than those without disabilities

WHY NO MEAT?

Why is fish permitted on Fridays?

Fish doesn't belong to the "flesh meats."

The Latin word for meat "caro" from which we get words like carnivore and carnivorous applies to flesh meat only and does not include fish.

Traditionally, meat was more expensive and eaten only during times of feasting and rejoicing.



What is considered flesh meat?

Flesh meat includes any meat from poultry or mammals, such as beef, chicken and pork. Products that come from these animals can be consumed on Fridays, such as milk and eggs.
