

The Hord is Risen! Allelnia! From the Pastor's Desk

A poet once *said*, *Love is not love if it has no future*. What Jesus revealed to us during his passion was his love for the Father and for us. The resurrection shows that the love of Jesus is a love with a future, and that future is eternal life in God's kingdom. Jesus' resurrection shows that love – God's love is stronger than death. Because the Father loves Jesus, the Father does not allow Jesus to remain in death. God raises him from death and, in so doing, conquers sin and death.

Jesus does not die for himself; he dies for us. Jesus rises again not only for himself but also for us. He rises from the dead so that those who believe in him and die to sin with him may also rise with him and live forever with him. Because the Father and Jesus love us, they have given us their Spirit, the Spirit of love. In his post-resurrection appearances, the risen Jesus reveals himself as present to his disciples. Nothing prevents him from being with them – not death, not the closed doors, not their fearful hearts. Let us remember that the risen Jesus is always with us till the end of time as he promised. And as the people of resurrection, nothing should prevent us from proclaiming in deeds and words that Christ is alive!

In light of the present situation unfolding before us regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) worldwide, our primary concern is the spiritual and physical health and welfare of the faithful and of all those who serve at our parishes, recognizing that we also have a duty to care for the community at large and the most vulnerable among us.

How to make a Spiritual Communion

There is no formula but some recommendations are

- Start with the sign of the Cross
- Read and reflect on the readings for Mass for the day

- Have a real desire to be united to Christ
- Acknowledge your sins and ask for forgiveness
- Receive Christ in your soul and pray an Act of Spiritual Communion
 Offer thanksgiving

St. Alphonsus Liguori's Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. Hove You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

What is Spiritual Communion?

Spiritual Communion is a way to be spiritually united to Christ when we are unable to physically receive the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist.

St. Thomas Aquinas defined it as "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Holy Sacrament and a loving embrace as though we had already received Him."
