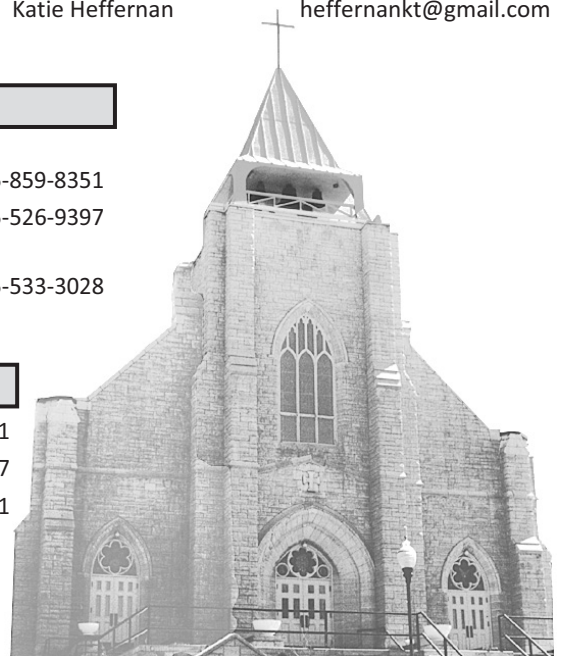

Consecration of **Archdiocese of** **Toronto to the** **Blessed Virgin Mary**

On May 1, 2020, each bishop in Canada and the United States consecrated their diocese individually to the Blessed Virgin Mary, to seek her protection for all the faithful, from the continuing Covid-19 pandemic. Priests, deacons, members of communities of consecrated life, families and individuals, were all encouraged to join their prayers in union with that of their bishop, in this consecration.

In the Archdiocese of Toronto, Cardinal Collins prayed the Consecration to Mary on May 1 at the end of his 7:30 a.m. livestreamed Mass, before the final blessing.

What happens when the doors to our Atrium have to remain closed

Our Atrium has remained closed since March Break, but the spirit of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd has been alive and well within our Atrium community. While families have tuned into online Masses and other

suitable programming to nurture their faith, many have also shared with us some very creative ways to be "Domestic Church".

One family drove out to a secluded beach one Sunday, where even the youngest participated in proclaiming the readings and prayers of the Sunday Mass.

A number of children created a prayer corner in their home, sometimes substituting a napkin or even a pillow case in the appropriate liturgical colour, decorating the prayer table with suitable items from their home, like a crucifix or other sacred image, a candle (to be lit only with parental supervision). Many children prepared prayer cards to place on the table, or chose songs to sing songs.

During the Holy Triduum families found various ways to commemorate Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. For the Last Supper, the ideas included researching traditional Passover foods for the evening meal and reflecting on this feast that Jesus had celebrated with his disciples, and the words he spoke that night, that no one had ever spoken before.

All children of one family collaborated on creating the Stations of the Cross, which were then installed in their backyard in time for a 3 o'clock Good Friday celebration.

Many family traditions were honoured in solemn and joyful celebrations of Easter, from decorating a Paschal Candle for the family home to baking "Resurrection cookies".

Conrad and I have frequently reached out to our Atrium families during these past weeks, and we have shared resources for parents and families like the ones in the link below that our fellow catechists from Australia and the United States have generously prepared for all of us: <https://cgsaust.org.au/parent-and-family-resources/>

This coming Sunday we will be celebrating Good Shepherd Sunday. In the absence of our usual celebrations in the Atrium we sent a Good Shepherd card to each Atrium child with the following invitation:

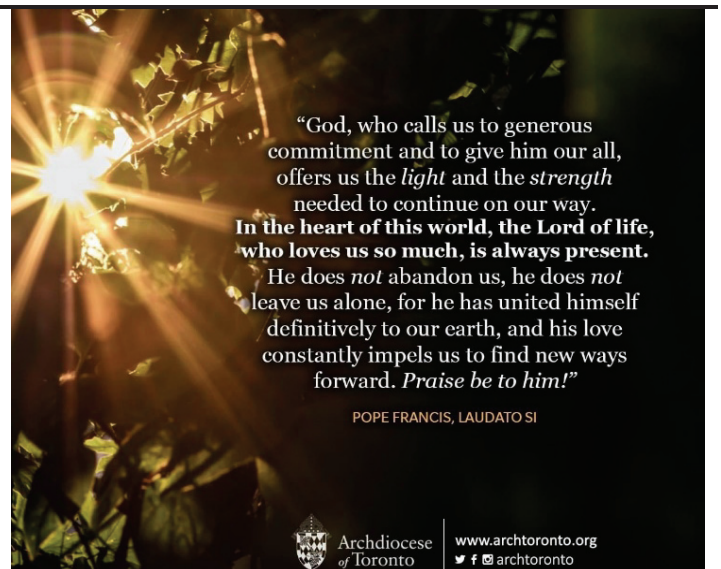
This Sunday will be Good Shepherd Sunday. How could we celebrate Jesus the Good Shepherd with joy? What could we do to show him our love in a special way? Here is what He told us in John 10:

"3 The Good Shepherd calls his own sheep by name and

leads them out. 4 When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. 5 A stranger they will not follow, but they will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers." 10b I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. 11 I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. 14 I am the Good Shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, 15 just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep. 16 And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd."

Jesus also shared another parable in the Gospel of Luke 15:4-6, which you can look up and read in your Bible. Could we prepare a prayer table for the Good Shepherd's Feast Day? What prayer card, or special drawing could we place on our table? Could we gather for a celebration to pray, sing...I'm sure you will come up with many more ideas.
