





Before the Ascension, Jesus tells His Apostles not to leave Jerusalem - to wait - to pray for the Holy Spirit to show them God's will for their future. Where is the Holy Spirit leading you? Chris Lemieux, Vocation Director, Archdiocese of Toronto 416-968-0997 There have been many prayers created to protect ourselves from COVID-19. However, there is a Psalm written thousands of years ago which seems incredibly appropriate for our current situation. Psalm 91 is a prayer of trust in God and in His protection."

Psalm 91 (RSV) Assurance of God's Protection

- 91 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High, who abides in the shadow of the Almighty,
- ² will say to the LORD, "My refuge and my fortress; my God, in whom I trust."
- ³ For he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence;
- ⁴ he will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.
- ⁵ You will not fear the terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day,
- ⁶ nor the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor the destruction that wastes at noonday.
- ⁷ A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand; but it will not come near you.
 ⁸ You will only look with your eyes
- and see the recompense of the wicked.
- ⁹ Because you have made the LORD your refuge,^[a] the Most High your habitation,
- ¹⁰ no evil shall befall you, no scourge come near your tent.
- ¹¹ For he will give his angels charge of you to guard you in all your ways.
- ¹² On their hands they will bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone.
- ¹³ You will tread on the lion and the adder, the young lion and the serpent you will trample under foot.
- ¹⁴ Because he cleaves to me in love, I will deliver him; I will protect him, because he knows my name.
- ¹⁵ When he calls to me, I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble,
- I will rescue him and honor him.
- ¹⁶ With long life I will satisfy him, and show him my salvation.
