# St. Vincent de Paul, St. Margaret's Conference



Self isolation and general health risks have impacted us all, including the efforts to offer support to the most vulnerable.

St. Vincent de Paul procedures have been streamlined to implement the social distancing requirements. We continue to operate our Food Pantry on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings 10:00am to 11:30am. Bags of food are prepared according to the number of people in the household and ready for pickup. The first three months of 2020, we served over 200 households, (including single, couples, 89 families with 276 children).

Our used furniture and household items service is on hold.

We are blessed with continued financial support from individuals, businesses and organization. This act of giving allows us to purchase the food for our pantry, assist with emergency funding for shelter, utility expenses, medication, eye wear, and transportation. These donations truly reflect awareness of the direct and essential needs of our community. We are extremely grateful.

## From the Pastor's Desk

#### Permanezcan *Amandose*

Picture yourself as Peter when Jesus asks you, 'Simon, son of John, do you love me?' Jesus asks you further, 'Do you know that I love you?' Wouldn't

you respond by saying, 'Lord, you know I love you. Thank you for coming back to me. I weep for the hurt and harm that I have inflicted on you and others. I failed you, but right now what I need most is your love. Comfort me and assure me of your love so that I can move on with my life.'

Again, Jesus asks, 'Simon, son of John, do you love me? Do you love me with all your heart? Do you love me so that you also know my heart? My sheep are hungry, thirsty and scattered. Some are in darkness and confusion forgetting who I am and what I have done to them. Do you really love me?' Wouldn't you reply and say, 'Lord, you know I love you. I need your love to free myself to pursue you. Love makes me wanting to feel and know your heart and mind. I want to hear your voice more closely. I want to share your thinking, your goals and your motivations for doing things.'


Third time Jesus asks, 'Simon, son of John, do you love me? Do you love me and love your neighbour? Do you love them so as to leave the ninety-nine and search for the one who is lost? Do you love them that you will give the most loving thing that you can offer and are willing to sacrifice everything you have for them?' Wouldn't you respond and say, 'Lord, you know that I love you. I need your love to fill my heart, transform my mind, and free my self in order to give myself in loving service to others.'



Perhaps at the end of the day, Jesus still asks: 'After all we have gone through, after all the experiences of pain, frustration and disappointment, do you love me? Even though the

other day you let me down, even though your words have hurt me so much, do you love me?'

We just had the Feast of the Lord's Ascension. We did not celebrate the end of Jesus' presence in the world. On the contrary, we celebrated the change of the way He is present in the world. Jesus is no longer physically present in the world through his human body. Instead, He is



present through his Mystical Body, the Church, in a spiritual way by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ is still with us and continues to see us with a loving heart. Further, He is not asking for plans, words and intentions – but for love. He wishes to replace every denial, every sin, every doubt, with a statement of our love for him. His question of 'do you love me?' opens the door of love and caring, the door of understanding and belonging together, the door in which emotions count and affection is essential.

If you feel that you are far from God, or you find it difficult to love God at this time, it may help to ponder his question 'Do you love me?' The love of God, being loved and cherished by God, loving God is what gives our lives their shape and form, their texture and fullness. Let us also remember the mode by which Jesus acts in the world today - through us. We are his hands and feet.

Let us close with a prayer
