St. Vincent de Paul procedures have been streamlined to implement the social distancing requirements. We continue to operate our Food Pantry on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings 10:00am to 11:30am. Bags of food are prepared according to the number of people in the household and ready for pickup. The first three months of 2020, we served over 200 households, (including single, couples, 89 families with 276 children).


Our used furniture and household items service is on hold.

At the start of time, God breathed... and the first human creature stood up and moved from being but a still-clay (Genesis 2:7). At the end of time, God will breathe... and the valley of dry bones will recover flesh and rise to new life (Ezekiel 37:9).

In the meantime, the Risen

Lord breathes... and the Church, since its birth on Pentecost Day, lives on through human history and mediates Christ's transforming presence among all peoples. From plants to humans within the vast expanse of land, seas and skies – all creatures form one planetary community through the simplest of all vital acts: breathing... constant feeding on unseen yet real oxygen everywhere.

Similarly, the Holy Spirit is the breath of the Risen Lord – that omnipresent air of love and peace on which the spiritual vitality of every Christian depends.

We are back to Ordinary Time in our Liturgical Calendar. During this time, it is important to remember our mission: as the Father sent me, so I am sending you!

We are sent. It was not the Church that thought up her mission, but it is a Spirit-led mission that gave birth to the Church. We may wonder we are sent for what. None has so far outdone classic theology in summing up the Church's mission among any people, of any culture, at any point of history. Three Greek words tersely say it:

Kerygma means to share – out of faith – the Good News of the wounded risen Christ in season or out of season.

Koinomia means to gather as believers – out of hope – in ways that our fellowship preview the Peace of God's reign.

Diakonia means to help – out of love – all of who suffer, preferentially the poorest at the margins of any society.


Gosh, one may say, what a grand project indeed! But the question is where and how I can make a humble start.

We are sent by Jesus with a precious gift. After He rose from the dead, Jesus appeared to his apostles in the Upper Room. Peace be with you! Christ said and showed them his hands and side. For those whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven.

If I were the wounded risen lord, petty as I am, my first words would have been to shame my disciples' cowardice for letting me down at the worst hours of my passion and death. Yet amid seething conflicts, only pardon can truly light up the hope of finding the lasting way to peace.

For most of us, faith has not really come from making a mental leap to belief, but from the joyous jump of being forgiven. For all of us, as for the Crucified Christ, to forgive is the ultimate test of self-giving love. And to forgive we are commanded by Jesus to do 'seventy times seven' – meaning countless times (Matthew 18: 22).

Let us end with a prayer:
Spirit of Christ, stir us;
Spirit of Christ, move us;
Spirit of Christ, fill us;
Spirit of Christ, seal us.
Consecrate in us Your Merciful
Heart and Gracious Will, O
Heavenly Father.
