

The 4 R's of Receiving Holy Communion

Following the directive of our Archbishop Cardinal Collins **Holy Communion is to be received on the hand only.** Follow these 4 simple steps, the 4 R's. These steps are in place to protect you, our priest and fellow parishioners.



Volunteer's Needed

Many hands make light work. Continuing to have St. Margaret's open to celebrate mass and receive other sacraments will need to translate into good deeds. We have masks, gloves, face shields/goggles for all volunteers. We are grateful who have already stepped forward but we are in need of more volunteers to share the workload and enable substitutions should someone need.

Ushering Ministry

Ushers greet parishioners as they enter the church, helping them navigate the safety protocols of our re-open (sanitizing stations, getting a mask should visitors have forgotten to bring one with them, finding a seat, and monitoring our capacity restrictions). We need volunteer ushers for ALL Weekday & ALL Weekend Masses. At least 4 ushers per Sunday Mass and at least 2 ushers per weekday mass are needed. Cleaning Ministry

We need volunteer cleaners for ALL Weekday & All Weekend Masses.
