

# The Pope's Prayer Intention

For May: The World of Finance

Let us pray that those in charge of finance will work with governments to regulate the financial sphere and protect citizens from its dangers.



## Reflection: Remain in Me

As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you: abide in my love (John 15: 9). This passage is one of the best-known discourses on love. The Greek word used is neither eros, the passion that seeks some form of possession of the person or object love, nor philia, but which denotes the love of kin or those very closely related.

The word used is *agape*, a word that in itself is very similar to *philia*, but which in the gospel of St. John has special theological meaning. It is the only word used to describe the love of God and it carries this connotation when applied to love of neighbour. The word appears nine times in this Sunday's Gospel, weaving together the love that God has for Jesus, the love of Jesus has for his friends and the love friends have for one another.

The source of this love is divine love itself: as the Father has loved me, so I have loved you... love one another as I have loved you. All of us disciples are invited to live in this love, to abide there. The verb menein means 'to stay on a place'. It suggests permanence associated with God. The union offered is not intended to be a passing moment; it is to be a lasting state of being. God's love is strong and constant, no matter what.

To remain in the love of God the Father is accomplished through obedience. In this, Jesus is both the model and the mediator. As He has been obedient to the commandments of the Father, so the disciple must be obedient to Christ's ordinances of love. In fact, it is in the obedience to Him that the disciple is obedient to the Father.

The power to love has its source in God. Embraced by God's, we are gradually transformed. We begin to recognize that it is boundless. This is seen in the fact that God loved us even before we are deserving of God's love (see 1 John 4: 7-10). In fact, it is God's love that enables us to receive and to love God in return.
