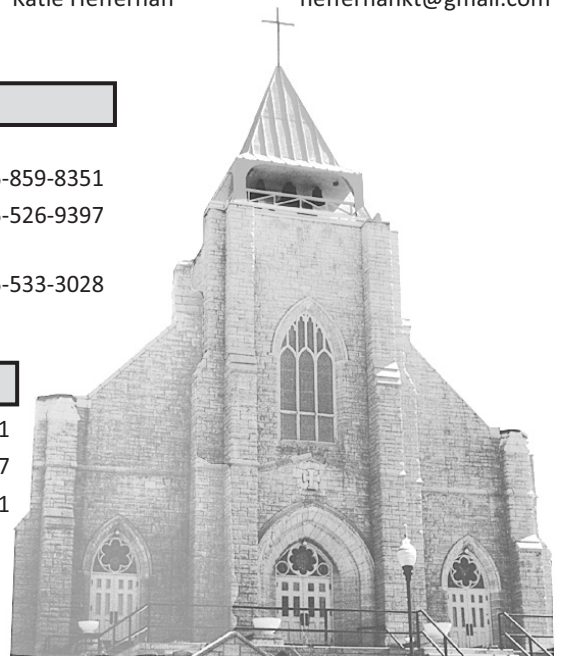

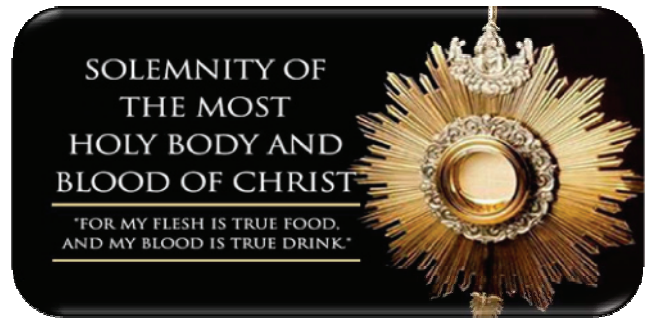

Evangelization: The Beauty of Marriage

Let us pray for young people who are
preparing for marriage with the support of aChristian community: may they grow in love, with
generosity, faithfulness and patience.**Reflection for this week: One with God**

Recognizing Jesus in the consecrated bread and wine is good, but it is simply not the total picture. When we make it the total picture, we seek to limit God and God can't be limited. Recognizing and experiencing God present within us, in each other, in everyone in the world is the whole picture of the Holy Eucharist.

Only when we begin to see God present in the world, in the person we dislike, in the child who won't behave, in your spouse, in the person who has wronged us – only then will the mystery of the consecration bring us to a sense of awe and thanksgiving.

Importance is therefore not based on who does or does not have God. Obviously, it is not based on intelligence, power, beauty or fame. Importance is found in sharing who we are with each other because everything is a gift. This is what happens when we celebrate the Precious Body and Blood of Jesus – that we are the Body and Blood of Jesus our Lord.

We celebrate God present within us in others, in all of creation, and in the bread that we break and the wine that we drink. We celebrate God not only in our church but also in our homes and in our places of work. We respect the earth and the environment because God is equally present here. We are drawn into an internal struggle when we see injustice and oppression.

We suffer with those who don't have enough to eat, or those who suffer from debilitating illnesses, or those who lost loved ones. We rejoice with the person who has received promotion ahead of us. We beg God to help us forgive when another does something against us.

Our daily toil to give life to others is also a share in Jesus' declaration: *This bread is my Body, this wine is my Blood, offered in love for you.* When we find ourselves living in this way, we will begin to know how to be holy as our Father is holy. When we do these things, then we are being eucharist for one another.
