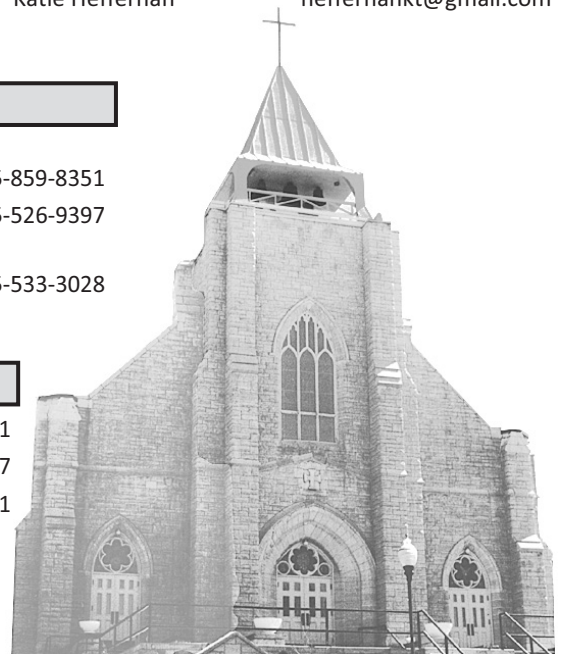

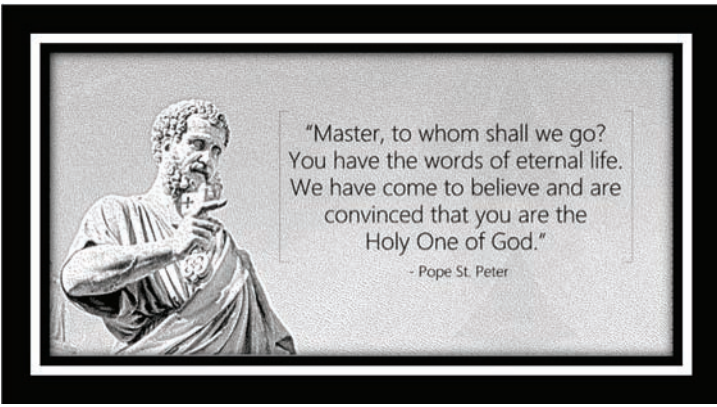

Reflection:

## The Holy One of God

*Do you also wish to go away? After Jesus told his listeners about himself as the bread of life, that unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you, many of his followers said, this teaching is difficult, who can accept it. And afterwards many of his disciples turned back and no longer went about with him. So, Jesus had to ask the Twelve, his chosen ones, do you also wish to go away?*

In his name and for the Twelve, "Peter answered him, *Lord to whom can we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe that you are the Holy One of God.*

Have we ever considered abandoning our faith and its beliefs? How did we react at those times?

Somehow, we have stayed despite our doubts and insecurities. Why – is it because we have nowhere else to go, or is it because Jesus had the words of eternal life? Because we have come to truly believe that He was the Holy One of God?

Considering some things could be helpful for us. First, God values our freedom. God is love and loves us, but he does not force his love on us; neither does he force us to love him back. Secondly, staying with God, we do need to constantly ask for his grace and help to be grateful for all he has done for and given to us and to ask to understand what it means to be with him and how to be able to live our lives accordingly. And thirdly, that, even if we rejected and said "no" to

God, he does not cease to love and to wait for us to come back to him.

In the first reading from Joshua (21<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time), Joshua asked the people: *If you are unwilling to serve the Lord, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served in the region beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whom the land you are living. As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.* The people replied, *far be it from us that we should forsake the Lord to serve other Gods.* Joshua said: *You yourselves are witnesses that you have chosen Yahweh to serve him.* They answered: *We are witnesses.*

Will we choose Jesus, with the incredible claims he makes? Or will we decide to stay where we are, satisfied with the lives we are living? Fr. Roselle
