



Reflection: Committed to Love

In our times today, there are people who do not believe in marriage. They claim "Why get tied down when live-in is a possibility?" Commitment seemingly becomes a hindrance to true freedom. Yet, we know that it is only when we commit ourselves, we truly become free. We are freer to love the other person and think of their welfare. Some would say that it is just a document that would attest to the state of these persons. Why go for an extra step of marriage when love is already present? Exactly, it is borne out of love that people would want to share and announce it to all. Hence, we say about premarital practices: just because many people do it does not make it right.

In doing so, you truly become sacraments of God, an actual witnessing of God's presence in our midst.


