

All Souls Day Nov. 2nd. EMORY There are envelopes in the back of the church. Fill one out with the names of your dearly departed and put it in the collection basket. They will go on the altar for the month of November.

All Souls Day Indulg Visit to a Church or Cratory on ALL Souls Day. PLENARY INDULGENCE. A plenary indulgence, applicable UNLY to the souls in purgatory, may be obtained by those who, on All Souls Day, piously visit a church and recite one (Jur Father and one Creed Visit to a Cemetery. Unty applicable to the souls in Purgatory when one devoutly visits and prays for the departed. A PLENARY INDULGENCE is bestowed for this work each day between November 1 and November 8.

Sent Forth Reflection:

The Church exists to evangelize. The Church, which is you and I, is missionary by nature. Through our baptism, we were incorporated into this body of Christ, the Church. For better or for worse, we are symbols of Christ in the world. It is, therefore, our mission, our very lifeblood to see Mission Sunday, which will be celebrated next weekend, not as an outsider, but as someone called to be on a mission.

Sadly, in the Church today many Catholics have been 'sacramentalized' but not catechized; baptized but not formed in the teaching of Jesus and his Church. A certain lethargy has attached itself to the Catholic Church, making us spiritually anemic, reluctant to share faith with others. We hear God's word and we are sometimes hesitant to live and proclaim it ourselves. We are to ask ourselves why - if the Word of God has not embedded itself within us, if Jesus means anyone or anything to us at all.

An old adage goes: we cannot give to others what we do not have ourselves. Hence, we need to be 'missionized'. If our Christianity is only a matter of rules and regulations like going to church on Sundays and not eating meat on Fridays, if our faith is only a matter of convenience and not of conviction; if Christ is only a statue and not a person whom we really know, then we are certainly thinking and viewing Mission Sunday as an outsider.

We need to have the faith level conviction in our intellect and in our heart. Once that happens, we will need no urging to witness to Christ. We will feel impelled from within to celebrate and share the life of Jesus. We are to begin today (Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time), which is actually called the 'Laity Sunday'.

Let us - both laity and ordained - light the lamp of Christ by what we say and what we live, by what we believe and what we stand for, and by the attitudes we manifest. May the people around us begin to see a difference in our lives, and let that difference be Christ himself. After all, He is there to inspire us every step of the way. Let us not forget that with this great commission: Go and make disciples of all nations, we also have his great promise: Know that I am with you always until the end of time.


