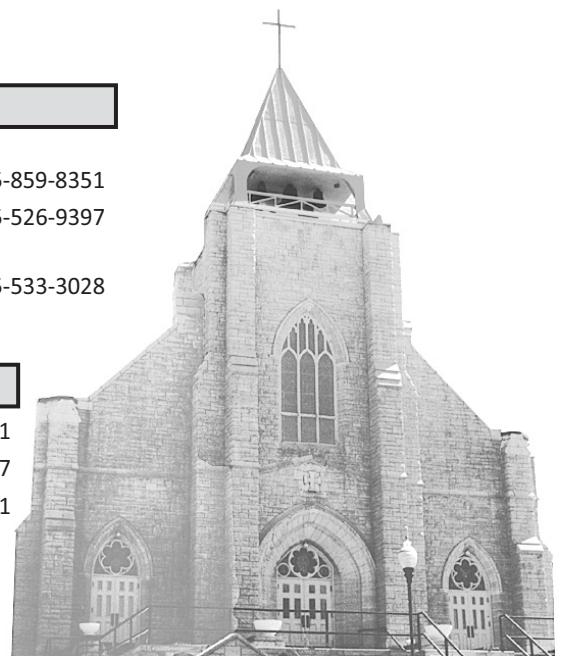

After Jesus told his listeners about himself as the bread of life, that *"unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you,"* many of his followers said, *"This teaching is difficult, who can accept it?"*
