

Blessed Are the Merciful

It is interesting to note the contrast that Jesus plays around with in the parable this Sunday (Luke 18: 9-14). He uses the person of the tax collector as contrast to the Pharisee. On the one hand, the Pharisees, in Jewish estimation, are the ones closest to God. On the other hand, the tax collector is the one who is not included in God's embrace. However, in the gospel, the tax collector is the one who comes out justified in the eyes of God.

There are two major points that need to be underlined in this Sunday's parable. The first is that a relationship with God does not happen because of what a person does, like fasting twice a week or doing what everybody is supposed to do as prescribed by the law. A relationship with God starts with God's initiative to enter into a relationship with us despite who we are and what kind of past we had. A relationship with God is offered to us by God for free. We don't merit it.

The second point is the definition Jesus gives to self-righteousness: it does not consist in feeling good about the laudable deeds one has performed; the essence of self-righteousness is scorning others, holding everyone in contempt. Look at what the Pharisee said: *I am not like other people: thieves, rouges adulterers, or even like this tax collector.* No one has the right to pass judgment on others. Surely, virtue and vice reside in every person. Only God knows our secrets and deepest desires. All we can see is the outside.

Let us leave the judging to God. What we do is beat our breasts and say: be merciful to me, O Lord, for we are just sinners. And like the tax collector who was a sinner like all of us, we might also leave justified in the eyes of God. Be merciful to us, Lord, and help us to become instruments of your peace.


