



Our New Archbishop

Who is Archbishop Francis Leo? On February 11, we received the news that Cardinal Thomas Collins was retiring as the archbishop of Toronto after 17 years, and that a new archbishop had been named by Pope Francis. Archbishop Leo who had been serving as an auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Montréal. All across the archdiocese of Toronto, there was eagerness to welcome our new shepherd. He is 51, which makes him one of the youngest Catholic bishops in Canada. He also brings a wealth of experience to his new ministry in Ontario.

A native of Montréal, Archbishop Leo was born in 1971, to parents who were immigrants from Italy (which is why his surname is pronounced LAY-oh, rather than LEE-oh). After theological studies at Montréal's Grand Séminaire, he was ordained to the priesthood in December 1996. He served in parish ministry at churches around Montréal for 10 years, before being invited to train as a Vatican diplomat. For six years, he served overseas at various Vatican nunciatures (embassies), before returning to Montréal to teach on the faculty of the Grand Séminaire, assisting in the formation of lay students and seminarians.

In 2015, Monsignor Leo became the General

Secretary of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, serving in that role until 2021. He became Vicar-General of the Archdiocese of Montréal in February of last year and, in July, Pope Francis named him as an auxiliary bishop for Montréal. On September 12, 2022, he was ordained as a bishop—meaning that he had only been a bishop for roughly six months when Pope Francis appointed him as Toronto's new archbishop. He was formally welcomed and installed in Toronto on March 25, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, and was recently welcomed to our region during a Mass of Welcome at St. Mary's parish in Barrie on April 11.

Did you know...?

Since very ancient times, public leadership in many Christian communities has taken the form of a threefold-ordained ministry: deacon—priest—bishop. Catholic theology under-stands all three of these ministries as differing expressions of a single sacrament, which Catholics call "Holy Orders". Whereas both deacons and priests can celebrate many sacraments, we understand the bishop to have the fullness of that sacrament, since there are certain sacred actions (including celebrating ordination) which are reserved to him.

In the New Testament, the role we today call "bishops" is designated by the Greek term *episkopos*, which literally means "overseer". The bishop's role is to watch lovingly and carefully over the Christian life of a particular region, called a diocese, and to support the living-out of the Gospel in that area. There are today more than 2200 Catholic dioceses around the world, and each diocese has at least one bishop (some larger dioceses also have auxiliary bishops, who assist the diocesan bishop in his work). All priests and deacons are mandated by their bishop, and they help to extend his work into local communities. A bishop must be at least 35 years of age, and must submit his resignation to the pope when he turns 75.


