



## The Pope's Prayer Intention for July

For a Eucharistic Life

We pray that Catholics may place the Celebration of the Eucharist at the heart of their lives, transforming human relationships in a very deep way and opening to the encounter with God and all their brothers and sisters.

## **Peace Be with You**

Fear is such a powerful emotion that TV has created program to exploit its entertainment potential. One series explored fear of the unknown by having blindfolded contestants identify objects and animals purely by touch, testing both physical and psychological courage. It rewarded as winners only those who managed to control their fears.

We often fear disgraceful disclosure. Who has not once stumbled uncharacteristically, or made an unforgivably careless mistake, or surrendered to a moment of weakness we regret interminably? Who has not been anxious that the dreaded or shameful regret will one day be revealed, stripping off our remaining self-esteem?

And yet, only those who humbly acknowledge fallibility can also experience the peace and liberation of self-acceptance. Admission and confession are types or moral courage. Reconciliation with those we hurt costs amply in terms of pride. Owning responsibility for injury requires integrity, and offering restitution is only possible to the once-again ennobled.

The Gospel this Sunday speaks of a more deadly fear, in fact, the fear of physical harm or even death from people so wicked they can harass those who do good and speak in the name of God. A careful life-review will show that now and then we were challenged to stand up for truth and decency, for God and our neighbor, and miserably failed the test.

For over self-preservation, we sometimes sacrifice others, even loved ones. Intimidated by actual (or imagined) threats, we sometimes could not muster up enough spirit to stand up for the right, or defend our religious beliefs or share our spirituality, shying away from witnessing to those who mock God or Jesus or Mother Church.

Everybody is afraid of something; but everyone can turn to Jesus to banish any kind of fear. *Fear not*. How many times have we heard that greeting and encouragement in Scriptures, addressed to so many individuals by Jesus in various moments of fear,

offering them his presence, peace and power? Jesus offers strength born of faith that there is life beyond death. He stirs up courage born of hope that sacrifices will not be in vain.
