# <u>Catechesis Of The Good Shepherd</u> <u>At St. Margaret's Church, Midland</u>

The Catechesis Of The Good Shepherd is an internationally recognized approach for the religious formation of children, which highlights essential aspects from Scripture as well as from Catholic Liturgy that nurture the child's capacity to enjoy and contemplate God's presence.

The sessions take place in the "Atrium", a room prepared especially for the faith formation of children and youth. The Atrium is directed by certified catechists who volunteer their time in service to the families of St. Margaret's Parish.

We hope to begin sessions the week of September 17th. The cost for the year is \$60 per child for the year, \$100 for 2 children, \$140 for 3+ children. Thursdays 4:30 to 6:30 pm: Levels I and II for children ages 4 to 7


Morning sessions for children from homeschooling families are available upon request.
