

For the gift of diversity in the Church

We pray that the Holy Spirit may help us to recognize the gift of different charisms within the Christian community and to discover the richness of different traditions and rituals in the Catholic church.

When One Believes

Motherhood (and fatherhood, for that matter) should be one of the most challenging roles a person takes in life. Consider how much time and care we lavish upon our animal pets, making sure that we give them the right food and protecting them from predators. How much more demanding is rearing a child or a whole family!

Imagine the anxiety (also the excitement, true) of making sure the growing life in the womb is secure until it is to be born into this world. Not to mention the pains of childbirth that first-time mothers vow are the most painful. Beyond this, motherhood, as our own mothers testify, demands so much more in terms of psycho-emotional, social, economic, and spiritual resources so the children can be provided with the best environment for growth into maturity. In a true sense, motherhood requires the whole life of a woman.

Today, a week after the birth of our Savior, we celebrate the solemn feast of his Mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary. While she was like us in all things, she was also very special in the eyes of God. She alone was spared from the stain of original sin as she was immaculately conceived. She was singled out from among women to the bearer of Jesus, the Son of God. In her lowliness, as she herself proclaims in the Magnificat – the Lord deigned to choose her and blessed her in a way no one else in the human race was.

While we praise and acclaim her for her blessedness, let us not forget what an enormous responsibility she was made to bear. It is difficult enough to be a good mother to a "mere" human being; how much more difficult it is to one who is both human *and* divine.

Further, motherhood demands maturity and readiness for such an enormous task. Mary was a very young woman, we suppose, when offered the task. Humanly speaking, she was not that ready to be the Mother of God or "God-bearer." And yet, she believed that the

God who called her and gave her the mission would also give her enough resources to fulfill the task.

As we celebrate the great gift of the motherhood of God that Mary received and carried out, we also remember how courageous and trusting she was, although she did not understand how everything would turn out. On this note, let us also pray for all mothers and mothers-to-be, especially those who are struggling with their challenging role, that God may bless them and endow them with the same courage and faith that Mary had.
