

## **Blossoming and Bearing Fruit**

In the Gospel (John 12: 20-23) this Sunday (Fifth of Lent), Jesus senses that the 'hour' of his end is getting close. Being in Jerusalem and having to face his enemies, he must realize that the moment is coming. Surprisingly, Jesus confesses that his heart is troubled. However, he also declares that he will not ask the Father to save him from the 'hour', for He says that He has come precisely to face the 'hour'.

Realizing, perhaps that his disciples need to understand and be strong before his impending suffering and death, Jesus declares to them, *unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains just a single grain; but if it dies, it bears much fruit* (verse 24).

Jesus understands that death to self is something necessary for everyone to go through in order to achieve a fuller life. The agricultural imagery illustrates very well how 'much fruit' or a 'greater harvest' can be reaped only if the seed falls to the ground and dies. We cannot keep the seed and bear fruit at the same time. This is the law of nature; this is the law of life.

Further, in this dying he is about to face, Jesus sees also his glorification. In the eyes of the Jewish authorities who put him to death, his death will mean his failure and their victory. But for Jesus and the Father, it will mark Jesus' vindication and glorification. It will also be the defeat of the evil forces. As the first chapter of the Gospel according to John foresees: *The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it* (John 1:5).

The philosopher Dietrich Bonhoeffer once said, 'There is no cheap grace, it is rather costly. There aren't any minimums. No bargaining is possible. A grain of wheat, which falls into the ground and dies, gives everything and surrenders everything.' As we wind up our Lenten journey and soon meet with Christ Jesus who suffers and dies, we too are to open ourselves to his call of surrender and self-emptying.
