

How to Use Electric Candlelighters

The parish now has new battery-operated lighters at the candle racks. To light a candle:

1. Slide the power switch "ON".

2. Press and hold the ignition button to start the

flameless electric arc, move the arc slowly toward the candlewick to light.

3. Slide the power switch "OFF", and hang lighter on hook.
