

Lumen Gentium Forum

Do you know talented, young Catholic professionals, with the potential to be impactful leaders in society for the mission of the Church? We invite you to share with them a newly launched fellowship program in the Archdiocese of Toronto, the Lumen Gentium Forum. The Lumen Gentium Forum is an eight-month experience focused on building up Catholic leaders for the Church and for society, offered by CAPP-Canada—the Canadian arm of a Vatican foundation founded by Pope Saint John Paul II—and launched in collaboration with the Archdiocese of Toronto.

Lumen Gentium Fellows will experience serious spiritual and intellectual formation with a focus on discovering Catholic social doctrine and its practical application to today's most pressing issues. They will participate in monthly meetings featuring Eucharistic adoration, dinner, small-group conversation and talks from senior Catholic leaders, together learning how to advance Gospel values in their industries and institutions. This is an extraordinary opportunity for young people who want to live out a Christian mission in their careers and cultural engagement—those eager lay apostles who, in

the words of Lumen Gentium, "seek the kingdom of God by engaging in temporal affairs and by ordering them according to the plan of God."

We are seeking your recommendations for candidates. Working Catholic professionals aged 25-40 can apply directly via the program website at

www.LumenForum.ca.

Applications will be reviewed as they are submitted, and the first round of accepted candidates will be informed after June 15. The cohort will launch in September 2024 and conclude in May 2025.

As you consider potential Lumen Gentium Fellows in your parish communities, we ask in your charity to also pray for this new initiative: that it serves as a means of developing young leaders in our Catholic community and the next generation of lay apostles who will bring the Good News to our neighbours across the region.
