August 7: St. Sixtus II (d. 258 AD)

St. Sixtus II was a Pope in the early church during the reign of Emperor Valerian. To hide from persecution, St. Sixtus II would hold services in the subterranean cemetery of Praetextatus on the [Appian Way](#).

August 7: St. Cajetan (1480 – 1547)

St. Catejan was a lawyer before being called to the priesthood. He is best known for founding the Theatines, a congregation focused on reviving the spirit and zeal of the clergy.

August 8: St. Dominic (1170 – 1221)

St. Dominic was a French-Castilian priest. He is the founder of the Dominican order and the patron saint of astronomers and natural scientists.

**August 9: St. Teresa Benedicta of the
Cross (1891 – 1942)**

St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross was born Edith Stein, a philosopher and university teacher until 1922, when she converted to Catholicism and entered the Carmelite order. She chose her name after Theresa of Avila. Teresa of Benedicta died in a gas chamber at Auschwitz in 1942.
