2024 Christmas Giving

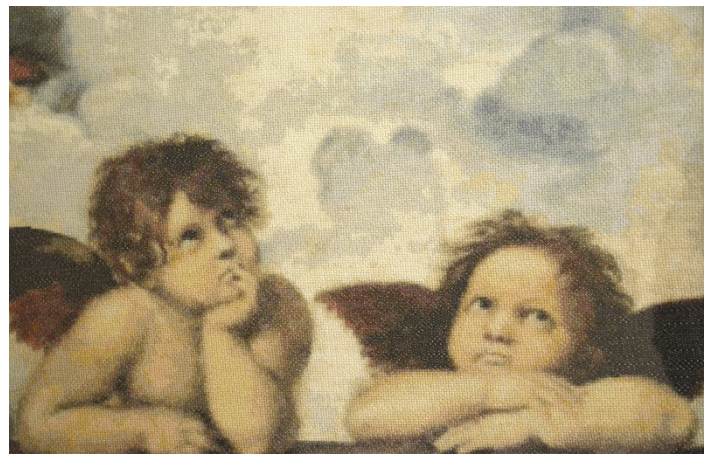
St. Vincent de Paul will be providing Christmas support to those in need in our community.
