



Pope's Prayer Intention for February

For vocations to the priesthood and religious life

Let us pray that the ecclesial community might welcome the
desires and doubts of those young people who feel a call to
serve Christ's mission in the priesthood and religious life.

Come, Follow Me

After preaching to the multitudes on the shores of the Lake of Gennesaret with Peter's boat as his pulpit, Jesus told Peter to set out to deeper waters for a catch of fish (Luke 5: 1-11). When we hear the call of God to do something which goes against our natural inclination, we are tempted to compromise our obedience in several ways. We are tempted to be guided by our acquaintances or by our own experiences instead of what God says. God may ask you to try again even if you have failed in the past. Will you allow past failure to keep you from following the Lord? Simon Peter and his companions needed to learn that obedience to Jesus should not hinge upon favorable circumstances. Will you allow circumstances to dictate your obedience to Jesus?

When Peter and his companions did Jesus' bidding, there was a miraculous catch of fish. On seeing this, Peter fell down at Jesus' knees saying, 'Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man'. At first, this request seems strange that he would ask Jesus to leave. This new revelation of the power and glory of Jesus has given Peter an acute sense of his own sinfulness. Peter was not really trying to get rid of Jesus. He was simply overcome with a sense of his own unworthiness. As our knowledge of Jesus deepens, we come to realize our own sinfulness. Then a consciousness of our sin drives us to Him for only He can save us.

Jesus told Peter that his future endeavor would not be catching fish, bringing them from life to death, but catching people, bringing them from death to life. On pulling their boat to shore, Peter and his companions left everything and followed Jesus.

The word 'followed' in the gospel signifies the deepest inward attachment to Jesus. 'Leaving everything' implies a question. Must all disciples leave everything for their vocation to serve Jesus? Not everyone is called into full-time ministry. The important element is that the call to walk with Jesus takes a priority, so that we are prepared to be whatever or whenever God calls us to be.

ABOUT ST. MICHAEL'S CHOIR SCHOOL

Founded in 1937 with the purpose of providing sacred music for services at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica in downtown Toronto, St. Michael's Choir School is a centre for musical and academic excellence. SMCS is one of only six choir schools in the world affiliated with the Pontifical Institute of Sacred Music in Rome. Each boy admitted to SMCS is trained in vocal and instrumental music and sings in at least one of the school's many choirs. In addition to the annual Christmas concert, the choirs of SMCS tour regularly and perform at many local events. Balancing the sacred and the secular is customary for the school. St. Michael's Choir School is not only renowned for its music program, but also for its academic achievement, consistently ranking at the top of Fraser Institute surveys. For 88 years, graduates of SMCS have pursued studies in science, education, medicine, law, business and, of course, music. The last category includes such well known musical artists as Michael Colvin, Stewart Goodyear, Kevin Hearn, John McDermott, Claude Morrison, Robert Pomakov, Michael Shade, Stephen Hegedus, Matt Dusk, Andrew Craig, Joshua Tamayo, Jordan DeSouza, and the late Michael Burgess, to name a few.
