

Lord. It is an annual worldwide Lenten initiative for Catholics to receive the mercy of God through Eucharistic Adoration and the sacrament of Reconciliation. This year's theme is 'Compassion', taken from Psalm 103:13 "As a father has compassion for his children, so the Lord has compassion for those who fear him." Pope Francis invites the entire Church to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the context of Fucharistic adoration... Lent summons us, enables us, to come back to the Lord wholeheartedly and in every aspect of our life. Pope Francis urges all Catholics to take up the Lenten journey with enthusiasm, sustained by almsgiving, fasting and prayer. If, at times, the flames of charity seems to die in our hearts, know that this is never the case in the heart of God! He constantly gives us a chance to begin loving anew.

In this Jubilee Year, it is my hope that we will have a 24-hour adoration for our Lord Jesus at St. Margaret's Parish. The plan is to begin adoration on **Friday, March 28, 2025 at 11:00 am** and conclude with the celebration of the Holy Mass on Saturday, March 29, 2025 at 10 am.
