A Reflection on the Feast of the Annunciation Let's place ourselves in the Blessed Mother's situation. An angel appears and shares the message that you are to become the Mother of God. This is quite a precarious scenario because you know you had no physical relations with any man, and now you are about to become an unwed mother. In this biblical era, you're already considered a second-class citizen because you're a woman. What makes it even more shameful is that you might be suspected of adultery as well, because you've already been betrothed to Joseph. That's pretty much finding yourself in a difficult situation.

Still, with great humility and deep faith, Mary accepts this mission assigned to her from above. No matter what others may think of her, she'll accept the task that God asks of her. Even Joseph accepts his calling and supports his wife. And our world has never been the same since.

We are to ask ourselves if we exude the same call to mission as Our Lady in spite of the difficulties that will come our way. We'd probably find ourselves running the other way. Or perhaps, we'll probably bargain with God to get someone else. But, when we are requested to service by our Creator, hopefully we can answer with total trust and complete abandonment.

And, with God's grace just like Mother Mary, others will benefit from our resounding "yes" to the Father's plan. May we always pray to be as ready as Mary to answer in the affirmative, especially if it involves a chance to save others.

#### ABOUT ST. MICHAEL'S CHOIR SCHOOL

Founded in 1937 with the purpose of providing sacred music for services at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica in downtown Toronto, St. Michael's Choir School is a centre for musical and academic excellence. SMCS is one of only six choir schools in the world affiliated with the Pontifical Institute of Sacred Music in Rome. Each boy admitted to SMCS is trained in vocal and instrumental music and sings in at least one of the school's many choirs. In addition to the annual Christmas concert, the choirs of SMCS tour regularly and perform at many local events. Balancing the sacred and the secular is customary for the school. St. Michael's Choir School is not only renowned for its music program, but also for its academic achievement, consistently ranking at the top of Fraser Institute surveys. For 88 years, graduates of SMCS have pursued studies in science, education, medicine, law, business and, of course, music. The last category includes such well known musical artists as Michael Colvin, Stewart Goodyear, Kevin Hearn, John McDermott, Claude Morrison, Robert Pomakov, Michael Shade, Stephen Hegedus, Matt Dusk, Andrew Craig, Joshua Tamayo, Jordan DeSouza, and the late Michael **Burgess**, to name a few.
