

# **Pope's Prayer Intention for October**

For collaboration between different religious traditions

Let us pray that believers in different religious traditions might work together to defend and promote peace, justice and human fraternity.

### Wavelengths

I suppose it is a common fear, the loathsome task of needing to contact one of the institutional "consumer help lines." I'm not sure how many minutes (hours) of my life I have lost while waiting on the phone, listening to canned, royalty-free music that repeats over and over in annoying monotony that breeds aggravation and irritation instead of bringing quiet comfort and ease.

On holiday Monday, I had resolved to complete my mother's income tax submission. I had started earlier in the year, but submissions needed to be made to the Government to stop pension payments, and government rebates and officially record her as deceased. Then there was this move happening which just slowed the process and stymied any motivation to get it done quickly and timely. This week was the week to get it all done.

I figured everything was in place and I could whip right through it. HA! I should have known better. I had to receive a proper account designation that allowed me to act as her representative. It didn't matter that I had been completing her forms for the last 10 years online. My mother couldn't enter her account to save her soul. But, once it was reported that she had died, I had to officially become her representative. I tried to enter into her file but her social insurance number was invalid. *Gulp*.

On the second day of trying to sort through it all, I was condemned to the unthinking, Canada Revenue Agency help line. In preparation, I topped up my beverage, took a "bio break", grabbed some nibbles and dialed the 1-800 number. My first message was that my wait would be between 15-30 minutes. That wasn't too bad: I can while away that much time playing backgammon on my phone. When I finally talked with a human being, she had to transfer me to someone more specialized.

Back on hold, listening to that boring music, (though I did have an option of pushing 1 for gentler music). Finally, I reached the so-called expert who was supposed to solve my issues. He rhymed off his employee number and all I remember was that it had a 6 in it, and his name began with the letter 'C'. As I explained the situation, he said these wonderful words, "I know exactly what to do." Music to my ears. It still took a long time but that was because he was checking out things, ensuring that things were in place and that the direction forward was active, working, and ready for me. It was the best experience I ever had with a help line! I couldn't complete the

final income tax, but now everything is in place. I thanked him profusely because this daunting weight was off my back. So, if you ever need to contact CRA, you should ask for the agent whose name begins with C and his employee number has a 6 in it. He was helpful, friendly and most importantly, competent. Thanks, "C".
