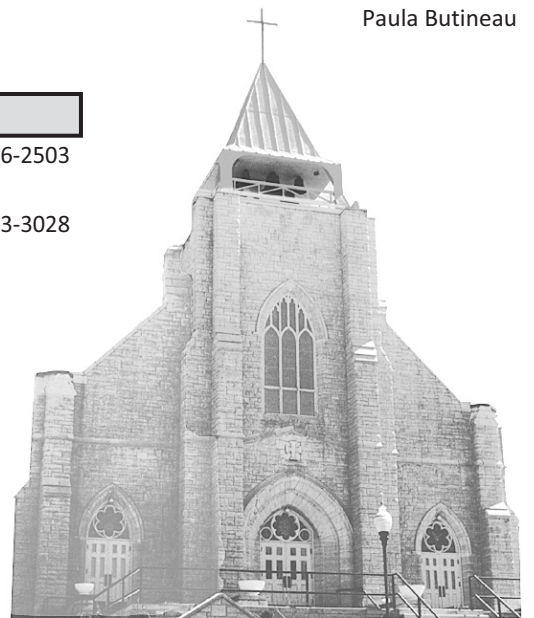

The little town of Holland Landing had two general stores, one at either end of Main Street. The one at the “other end” eventually housed the Post Office until a proper standalone building took its place. It was beside one of two service stations because back in the day, you drove over a hose that rang a bell to signal the attendant to come and gas up the car. There was usually a quick washing of the windshield, an oil check, and then a lengthy conversation about the goings-on in the “Landing”. (I guess it was the equivalent of office water cooler conversations.) There was no such thing as a “quick in and out” gas stop.

At our end of the retail centre was a little store where we had “our” *Toronto Star* newspaper slot that we would go in and pick up after school. Mom often phoned the store and asked the owner to include a loaf of bread or bag of milk that would be duly noted in the credit book and paid promptly on Thursdays – pay day.

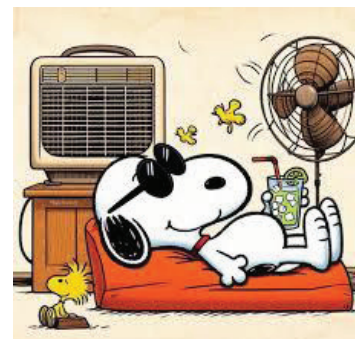
For one Fathers’ Day, my brother had set his eye on a particular little trophy that had a depiction of a rather haggard dad with empty pockets and a caption that said, “Work Sucks”. He didn’t really understand the sentiment; he just liked the figurine. If you looked at it cross-eyed with your head tilted and if you squinted really tightly, you might say it resembled our father, at least in his vision of Dad. It was his way of “awarding” Dad a trophy. We have had years of laughter about it ever since.

As we grew older and started having jobs, we had a tendency of pooling money and getting larger gifts. When I got my first job, Mom and I decided to surprise Dad with an air-conditioner – well, it was partly for Dad, but really, it was for all of us.

I can’t imagine how we survived without air conditioning. The prior attempts at cooling the house were to open windows and screens, hoping to create a cross breeze. Fans that simply blew hot air from one side of the room to the other, sitting with wet face towels on our face and neck, and complaining about the heat.

I can still picture Dad arriving home from the hot drive to Toronto, coming through the front door and immediately recognizing that a little piece of heaven had come to our house. He bee-lined it to the window, ripped open his shirt, and stood bare-chested in front of the cold air emanating from the new contraption.

It seemed like forever that he stood there, soaking in all the beautiful cold air. That marked the day when civilization entered our home. Happy Fathers’ Day.

### St. Vincent de Paul Update

If you have been to the grocery store, then you have seen that food prices have increased as much as 40%. ### St. Margaret's Elevator Campaign

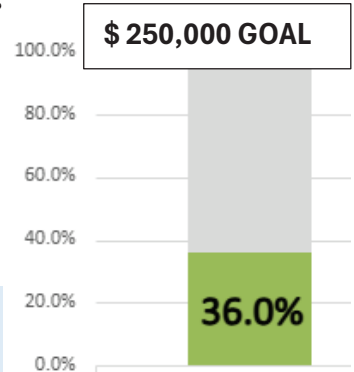
We are raising money for a commercial elevator that can accommodate at least five people, including one wheelchair user would provide greater accessibility between the church and lower level.
